**Text:** Exodus 20:17

**Topic(s):** Coveting

**Bottom Line of the Message:** Coveting is a lack of trust in God.

Soon it starts to dominate our thoughts, until finally it becomes an obsession. By the time we reach this point, sin will have its way with us.”
  - a. How have you seen this payout in your life? (Give example if you want to go deeper)
