 a. What does being open handed look like? Explain
- 3. Kyle said, "When we are close handed, we are being selfish by holding on to things."a. What does being close handed look like? Explain
- 4. Looking at your own life, which do you tend to be more of: Open or Close handed?
- 5. Read Acts 3:5-7. Peter couldn't give what the beggar wanted but was able to give him what he needed.
 - a. How can we identify the difference between a person's wants and needs?
 - b. Describe how we can help with the needs of the poor?
- 6. Bottom Line: The Ultimate Need is Jesus Christ.
 - a. Is this true and how do you know?
- 7. NextStep: Remember. Deuteronomy 15:7 Moses reminds the Hebrews of what God has done for them so that they would be open handed with the poor.
 - a. What has God done for you?
