Main Text: Matthew 28:16-20, Acts 1:1-11

Topic: Evangelism, Evangelism at home, witness

Bottom Line: Evangelism Starts at Home

NextStep: 1. Follow the Example (Jesus) 2. Be the Example

Discussion Questions:

1. Why should we evangelize?
2. **Read Matthew 28:16-20** Jesus reminds the Disciples that he is with them “to the end of the age.”
 - a. Is knowing God is always with you a comfort? Why or why not?
 - b. How does knowing God is always with you impact you sharing Jesus with others?
3. **Read Acts 1:6-11.** Jesus tells the Disciples that they will be His witness. Another word for witness is Testimony. Your Testimony is sharing what you have witnessed in your relationship with Jesus.
 - a. Share your testimony by answering the questions below:
 - i. What HAS God done in your life?
 - ii. What IS God doing in your life?
4. In **Acts 1:8**, Jesus tells the disciples to start evangelizing in Jerusalem which was like their home. The Bottom Line was “Evangelism starts at home.”
 - a. Does the bottom line excite you or worry you? Why?
5. **Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Ephesians 5:22-33.** Both passages of scripture speak about sharing Jesus in our homes.
 - a. What are some practical ways you are or could be sharing Jesus at home?
6. **Read John 13:13-16.** Jesus, while in a house with the Disciples, washes their feet.
 - a. How does what Jesus do help us evangelize at Home.
7. **Read 1 Timothy 4:12.** One of this week’s Next Steps was “Be the Example.”
 - a. How does being an example help to share about Jesus in our home?
