Overall Point: Jesus Christ can change your life because he is alive today

Challenge: Be a Participant

Discussion Questions:

- 1. "We all have had people who we have met, and it changed our lives because of the affect they have on us."
 - a. Who has affected your life the most? Explain.
- 2. Jesus healed a man who was born blind (John 9:1038). He opened the man's eyes so that he could see the truth of who Jesus is... The savior of the world!
 - a. How have you seen Jesus in your life lately?
- 3. Read Ephesians 1:18-20a. Kyle said, "When we allow Jesus to open our eyes to his love and his grace Paul tells us that we can live a life that filled with hope and joy. A life that is empowered with the same power that rose Jesus Christ from the grave. A life that is radically different because we are viewing life through his eyes."
 - a. What do we allow Jesus to open our eyes?
 - b. How does viewing life through Jesus eyes change our life?
- 4. Read Luke 23:39-43. The criminal on the cross shows us that it is NEVER too late to seek salvation.
 - a. Why is salvation sometimes the last thing we seek?
 - b. Do you believe that it is fair that the criminal will be in heaven with Jesus? Why or why not?
- 5. Read Luke 8:1-2. Mary was captured by 7 demons until Jesus freed her. We too can be captured by life's circumstances.
 - a. What are some of life's circumstances do you feel captured by?
 - b. Has Jesus freed you from captivity? Explain.
- 6. Read John 11:21-26. Jesus has risen from the dead and is alive today! Because he is alive, we can be alive in him!
 - a. Do you believe this?
 - b. How does this affect your life?
