Discussion Questions:

1. Describe your father or father figure.
 - a. From the perspective of a child, how would you describe God as father?
2. Webster Dictionary defines worship as: to regard with great or extravagant respect, honor, or devotion.
 - a. What other words would you use to define worship?
3. Kyle said, "Everyone worships, but it might not be God."
 - a. Thinking of the definition of worship, what other people/things do people worship?
 - b. If there was a fly on the wall following you throughout the day, what would it say YOU worship?
4. **Read Genesis 22:5.** Abraham is the first to equate sacrifice as worship.
 - a. How does this affect your thought about worship?
5. **Read Romans 12:1.** Paul challenges Christians to be living sacrifices for God as a form of worship.
 - a. What does this look like practically in your life?
6. **Read 2 Samuel 6:16-23.** David says that he will become "even more dignified" for the Lord. David was lowering himself and exalting God.
 - a. Why is it difficult to humble ourselves and exalt God?
 - b. What does it look like if we were to become undignified before God?
