Challenge: Ask God for wisdom in all things

Discussion Questions:

 - **a.** What is the difference between knowing and understanding?
 - **b.** How does this thought process translate to a relationship with Jesus? (You can know about Jesus yet not understand him or be in a relationship with him.)
- 3. Read James 3:13-16. James speaks about an Earthly wisdom
 - **a.** How would you define Earthly wisdom?
 - **b.** How have you seen Earthly wisdom?
 - **c.** Truthfully, do you tend to us this wisdom in your life?
- **4.** Read James 3:17-18. James speaks about Heavenly wisdom
 - **a.** How would you describe wisdom from above to someone who has never heard about it?
 - **b.** How have you seen Heavenly wisdom?
 - c. How have you USED heavenly wisdom and what was the result?
- **5.** Read Proverbs 2:1-6.
 - **a.** What does it look like to live out what Solomon is telling us?
- 6. Red Proverbs 1:1-7. Solomon how to find wisdom. (vs. 7)
 - a. How can we become wise when we "Fear the Lord?"
 - b. What does wisdom look like as a Christian?
